What is “Title I-A”

- Title I-A is the United States Government’s largest education assistance program for schools.
- Funds are used to provide programs to help children who are struggling in reading and math.
- Extra support (in addition to what students receive during math and reading in the classroom) is provided.
- Funding for the support is allocated under ESSA (Every Student Succeeds Act)





Title I-A Program Design

- Camas Valley is a School-Wide Program
 - A school-wide program serves all students.
- Camas Valley Title Program
 - Curriculum and Interventions
 - McGraw Hill (Reading)
 - SIPPS, Phonics for Reading, Rewards (Reading Interventions)
 - Big Ideas (Math)





Assessments & Monitoring

- Assessments used to measure student progress.
 - Formative – ongoing, informs instruction
 - Summative – SBAC, Dibels, iReady
- Notification of your child's assessment results.
 - Progress reports and other data discussed at conferences
 - SBAC results are sent home yearly, usually with report cards





Assessment & Monitoring cont...

- Progress Monitoring
 - DIBELS
 - iReady Reading & Math
- Response to Intervention (Rtl)
 - All students part of Rtl
 - 8 – 10 staff running groups at a time
- Tier Three Intervention
 - Individualized small group explicit and direct instruction
